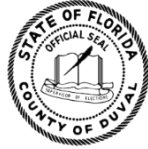

<b>Qualifying Documents                  And Fee</b> (If applicable) All items must be filed before the end of the qualifying period	<a href="#">DS-DE 303JU</a> Candidate Oath Judicial Office ( <b>Notarized</b> ) <a href="#">Form 6</a> – Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests 2019 ( <b>Notarized</b> ) <b>Qualifying Fee:</b> A candidate selecting to pay the qualifying fee or who is unable to meet the petition requirement shall submit a properly executed check drawn upon the candidate's campaign account (F.S. 99.061, 99.092, 99.0955, 99.096)
