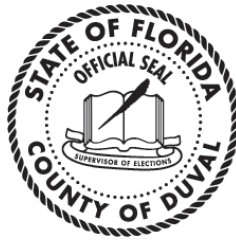

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Election Dates:	Primary, August 23, 2022 and/or General, November 8, 2022
Term of Office:	4 years
Term Begins: F.S. 100.041(3)(a)	Second Tuesday following the General Election November 22, 2022
Qualifications:	Registered voter of and resident of district Must reside in and be qualified elector of the district 183 days prior to qualifying
Residency Deadline:	December 16, 2021
Electorate:	Registered voters of the district
Annual Salary	\$44,597.00 SUBJECT TO CHANGE
Qualifying Period:	Noon, June 13, 2022 thru Noon, June 17, 2022
Method of Qualifying:	Qualifying fee: \$1,783.88 SUBJECT TO CHANGE (4% of the annual salary as of July 1, 2021) OR Petitions Process: In a year of apportionment, a candidate for county office shall obtain 1% of total registered voters divided by number of districts (7). District #2 - 949 District #4 - 949 District #6 - 949
Filing for Office: Forms required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DS-DE 9 Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository is required to be filed with the SOE office prior to opening a campaign account, accepting, or expending funds and reproducing petitions for circulation. • DS-DE 84 Statement of Candidate is required to be filed within 10 days after Form DS-DE 9 has been filed with the SOE office.
Petition Information: Petition form	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DS-DE 104 Candidate Petition is the petition format prescribed by the Division of Elections and shall be used by the candidate to reproduce petitions for circulation.
Petition Deadline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Noon, May 16, 2022
Petition Fee For Verification	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The SOE shall be paid in advance the sum of 10 cents for each signature verified (F.S. 99.097) • If a candidate cannot pay such charges without imposing an undue burden on personal resources or on the resources otherwise available to the candidate, an Affidavit of Undue Burden may be filed with the SOE to have the signatures verified at no charge (FS 99.097)
Prior to Closing Campaign Account:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to disposing of surplus funds in the campaign account, a candidate (excluding a write-in-candidate) who qualified by the petition process and filed an <i>Affidavit of Undue Burden</i> to waive the petition signature verification fee, must reimburse the SOE the amount of the waived fee (FS 106.141)
Qualifying Forms And Fee (if applicable): All items must be filed before the end of the qualifying period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DS-DE 304SB Candidate Oath – School Board NonPartisan Office (Notarized) • Form 6 – Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interests 2021 (Notarized) • Qualifying Fee: A candidate selecting to pay the qualifying fee or who is unable to meet the petition requirement shall submit a properly executed check drawn upon the candidate’s campaign account
