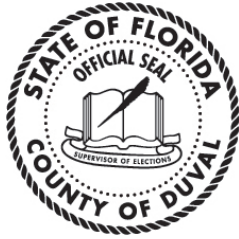

Term Begins:	Second Tuesday following the General Election November 22, 2022
Qualifications:	Registered voter (See residency qualifications for special districts)
Term of Office:	4 years
Electorate:	Registered voters of the district
Qualifying Period:	Noon, June 13, 2022 through Noon, June 17, 2022
Qualifying Fee:	\$25.00 (<i>May be paid by personal funds – cash, money order, cashier’s check, or personal check</i>)
Method of Qualifying:	1. Qualifying fee OR 2. Number of petitions needed: 25 DS-DE 104 Candidate Petition Petitions must be submitted to the Supervisor of Elections office prior to Noon, May 16, 2022
Filing Documents:	DS-DE 9 Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository <i>*Pursuant to 99.061(3) a candidate who does not collect contributions and whose only expense is the filing fee is not required to appoint a campaign treasurer or designate a primary campaign depository</i> AND DS-DE 84 Statement of Candidate OR AFFIDAVIT OF INTENTION Special district candidates who do not intend to collect contributions or make expenditures are required to file the above form with the Supervisor of Elections (SOE)
Qualifying Documents:	DS-DE 302NP Candidate Oath (Notarized) AND FORM 1 Statement of Financial Interests 2021
