Public Logic and Accuracy Test Scheduled for Thursday, November 18, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. at Election Center

JACKSONVILLE – Duval County Supervisor of Elections, Mike Hogan, announced the time and date for a Logic and Accuracy Test preceding the December 7 First Special Unitary Election. The Logic and Accuracy Test, mandated by Florida statute, will take place Thursday, November 18, 2021 at 9:30 a.m. inside the Election Center at One Imeson Park Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida, 32218.

For the test, election staff members will display voting tabulators in operation for the Election Canvassing Board, members of the press, and the public. This test determines if the machines are working properly and counting votes accurately.

The voting tabulators are chosen at random, corresponding to each Jacksonville City Council District and one Early Voting Site. A total of fifteen machines will be chosen.

The Logic and Accuracy Test is predicted to take approximately 90 minutes.
