It is with gratitude that we arrive at the begining of 2018. It has been our privilege this past year to complete many activities related to elections. We have held voter registration drives at schools, sporting events, and city festivals throughout Duval County. Additionally, our office has processed over 16,000 applications for voter registrations new to Duval County in 2017.

Recently the Florida Legislature passed a law allowing citizens to register to vote online. In accordance with this law, our office launched the Register to Vote Florida link on our website. Registertovoteflorida.gov allows you to submit an application online for new voter registration, make changes to your existing registration record, or prefill a voter registration application form. You will soon see the launch of our newly updated website, www.duvalelections.com. I hope that you will find the new format easier to navigate and find answers to your election-related questions. I encourage each of you to browse the website. It is a treasure trove of historical information, current candidates, voter statistics, and up-to-the-minute election results.

Available now is the 2018-2019 edition of the Duval County Supervisor of Elections Calendar. I hope you will find it not only informative but beautiful as well. Because we are a city of bridges, we are highlighting our bridges in this calendar edition. Significant dates in this 18-month calendar include the gubernatorial and congressional primary and general election dates. As always, I count it a high honor and privilege to serve the voters of Duval County. I wish you all a healthy and prosperous new year!



Spotlight on *Outreach*

Outreach to Duval County’s citizens acts as one of our most important functions at the Supervisor of Elections Office. As you know, outreach involves speaking engagements, voter education, community events, and voter registration drives. 2017 kept the outreach program busy.

Activities included:

- Countywide Student Voter Registration Drive. This past April over two days, 55 election workers ran simultaneous voter drives in 21 Duval County Public High Schools. Private high schools were also in the annual mix in the countywide voter registration effort designed to pre-register 16 and 17-year-olds and register those 18 years old and over.
- Jacksonville Sharks Sponsorship Game. In June our office partnered for the second consecutive year with our local arena football team the Jacksonville Sharks. At the game sponsored by our office, 30 election workers held a flag large enough to cover almost the entire arena football field during the singing of our National Anthem. The first 600 fans in line received a commemorative Jacksonville Sharks Voter Appreciation t-shirt. Programs were stuffed with a “play” ballot where fans of all ages could vote on playful trivia questions about the Jacksonville Sharks.
- School Elections throughout the County. Our office assisted in administering elementary, middle, and high school elections. At the invitation of the individual school, we provided voting booths and at times ballots and educational staff. In 2017 we worked with San Mateo Elementary, Saint Clair Elementary, Chets Creek Elementary, Kirby Smith Middle School Bridge to Success Academy, Young Women and Men’s Leadership Academy, and Westside High School. Our office applauds these and all the schools that stress the importance of educating our voters of tomorrow.

Throughout 2018 as before, Duval County citizens will be able to register to vote, update their voter information, and receive voter education information at our drives.
