Early Voting

Please join us to work early voting! If you have worked at least two (2) elections, have the ability to work four to five days consecutively, and have an email address, then you are eligible to apply. Interested? Email Autumn Hinson at autumnf@coj.net to be added to our contact list. All communication regarding early voting is completed by email. NO calls will be accepted due to the volume of participants.

Staffing

The Duval County Supervisor of Elections deployed 1,500 poll workers for the March 15 PPP. We need 1,850 for November's Presidential General Election. There is a need for additional poll workers in all 14 City Council Districts. The greatest needs are at the Beaches, the Intracoastal Waterway area and east of I-95. A number of precincts in all areas of Jacksonville need Republicans and NPA's to ensure we have party diversity as required by law. There are openings for Managers and Assistant Managers due to retirements and people moving out of county.

Thank you to all who have accepted assignments across town and arrived on time and ready to work.

Supervised Vote-by-Mail Voting Program

It's that time again to prepare for Supervised Absentee Voting in Duval County. We have conducted this program since 2002 to all voters residing at an assisted living or residential facility (F.S. 101.655). The program offers residents of these facilities who are not physically able to travel to an early voting site or polling location another option of access and convenience in voting.

We are recruiting poll workers to join us in conducting this program. In order to participate you must have your own transportation and you must attend ONE of the two training classes being conducted on Tuesday, July 12, at 10 am or Thursday, July 14, at 6 pm. Important *Training Information*

Training Update

2016 Primary Election

All experienced **Precinct Managers and Assistant Managers** must attend a 3-hour classroom training session prior to the August 30 Primary Election.

New **Inspector Techs** must attend a 4-hour classroom training prior to the August 30 Primary Election. Experienced **Inspector Techs** must attend a 3.5-hour classroom training session prior to the August 30 Primary Election.

All new or experienced **Deputies** must attend a 1-hour classroom training session prior the August 30 Primary Election.

All experienced poll workers being promoted to Manager or Assistant Manager must take the 8-hour New Manager and Assistant Manager classroom training session.

Training for the Primary Election will begin on June 6, 2016, and run through August 6, 2016.

NOTE: If you have not successfully completed training by August 6, you will not be assigned to work in the Primary Election.

How to Register

To register for a class, go to www.duvalelections.com, scroll down, click on POLL WORKER on the left hand side, and click on REGISTER FOR A CLASS. On the next screen click on ELECTION WORKER PORTAL. Remember, your VOTER REGISTRATION NUMBER is both your user name and password. Have this handy before you register. You will enter your voter registration number here for both your user name and password then click LOGIN. Please do not make any changes to your user name or password.

How to Register (continued)

Now you are at the screen where you register for your class. Select your class by clicking on ENROLL to the right of the class you want to take. You will see the word ENROLL change to the word WITHDRAW. THIS MEANS YOU ARE NOW ENROLLED IN THAT CLASS. You will see the number of seats remaining drop by one which means you have been assigned a seat. Should you wish to withdraw, simply click WITHDRAW and you will be removed from that class. Once enrolled, just show up to take the class at the assigned time. It is imperative that you arrive on time for your training class. Arriving late disrupts the class, and you may have to be rescheduled.

EXPERIENCED PRECINCT MANAGERS and ASSISTANT MANAGERS must enroll in an **EXP MANAGER & ASST MANAGERS CLASSROOM** course.

EXPERIENCED INSPECTOR TECHS should enroll in an **EXP INSPECTOR TECHS CLASSROOM** course. If you have never worked with the Electronic Voting Identification (EViD) system which was implemented in 2014, you must enroll in a New Inspector Tech course. NEW INSPECTOR TECHS should enroll in an **NEW INSPECTOR TECHS CLASSROOM** course.

DEPUTIES, whether experienced or new, enroll in a **DEPUTY CLASSROOM** course.

EVID, DS200 & AUTOMARK: PRACTICE & TAKE A CLOSER LOOK!



During these dates and times we will be conducting informal demonstrations and allowing for hands-on practice time working with our EViD, DS200 and AutoMARK machines. We can answer questions and help you better prepare for the August 30 Primary. This is completely optional and designed to help those election workers who feel the need for a bit of practice and one-on-one time with an instructor. You do not need to schedule this with us. Simply show up during the open times below:

FIRST TIME POLL WORKER?

If an individual desires to work in a precinct and has never worked with us before or has never worked with the new Electronic Voting Identification (EVID) system that has been in place since 2014, he or she will need to sign up for the NEW INSPECTORS or DEPUTY training to work on Election Day. If the individual has been recruited to work as an assistant manager, he or she must complete the NEW INSPECTORS training and then complete the NEW MANAGERS & ASST MANAGERS training.

Newly recruited workers will not be able to access the online registration system. All new workers must email John Libby at jlibby@coj.net to register.

All elections workers, including the deputies, must complete training prior to the August 30 and November 8 elections.
