Duval County Supervisor of Elections Regarding Senate Bill 90

JACKSONVILLE – Duval County Supervisor of Elections, Mike Hogan, and his staff will review election policies and procedures related to Senate Bill 90, which was signed into law on Thursday, May 6, 2021, by Governor Ron DeSantis.

“My staff and I will spend the coming weeks reviewing policies and procedures to ensure compliance with new state election laws,” Hogan said.

Also on May 6, 2021, a lawsuit was filed in the US Federal District Court in Tallahassee challenging portions of Senate Bill 90. All 67 Florida Supervisors of Elections are named as defendants, along with the Secretary of State and others.

“Since this matter now involves litigation,” Hogan said, “our attorney has recommended that neither my staff nor I make any comments concerning the new law.”

The Duval County Elections Office remains committed to continue making voting as convenient and accessible as possible, while faithfully complying with new laws established by our lawmakers.
